The Narayangaon Block in Maharashtra faced issues such as poor road connectivity, water shortages for irrigation and lack of healthcare facilities. The Panchayat Samiti took action by planning development projects with inputs from the Gram Panchayats. They proposed building all weather roads under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana, improving connectivity for farmers. To address water shortages, the Panchayat Samiti implemented a watershed management programme, including rainwater harvesting and check dams. They also collaborated with the district health department to establish a primary healthcare center.
